MATTERS ARISING

Highway Matters: Any problems will be reported. The lack of signage at the bridge on Woodlands Hill has been reported but as yet nothing has been done. Mrs Warren to chase up.

Police Report: There was no report available.

Playing Field: The rope frame has been repaired and the remaining wooden posts in the play area have been strengthened.

North Devon and Torridge Local Plan: No news.

North Devon Communities Fund: The drive carefully signs are now in place.

Eastacott Cross: Mr Nick Russell, Assistant Inspector of Ancient Monuments, Historic England, has become involved and has contacted Devon Highways but has not yet had a reply. The Parish Councillors think that the best long term solution would be to move the cross further away from the road.

Umberleigh Railway Bridge: Cllr Richard Edgell will be contacting the Highways department to ask for better signage. The Police agreed to monitor the speed of vehicles on the stretch of road past the school in Umberleigh. Cllr Mr Ives and Mrs Warren were with the police and vehicles exceeding the limit were stopped and the drivers spoken to about the dangers of exceeding the speed limits near schools.
